

STADIUM RULES

1. **NO LOITERING.** This policy is designed to enhance crowd control and safety. All spectators will need to be seated in the stadium during the course of any athletic event. This change will impact students and young children who have traditionally gathered in areas around the stadium or under the bleachers. Younger students who are dropped off without adult supervision will be required to sit in the general admission section throughout the entire game. An adult must accompany students in K through 5th grades.
2. **NO OUTSIDE MUSIC/PA SYSTEMS ALLOWED IN THE STADIUM.** Visitors must use the Celina I.S.D. PA system.
3. **ALCOHOL, TOBACCO, AND FIREARMS** are prohibited, by law on school property.
4. **GLASS CONTAINERS AND BOTTLES** are not allowed in the stadium.
5. **INDIVIDUAL COOLERS, ICE CHESTS, LARGE FOOD OR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS** are not allowed in the stadium.
6. **BACK PACKS AND LARGE BAGS** are subject to search.
7. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK** is allowed in the stadium, including bottled water.
8. **NO OUTSIDE FOOD OR DRINK** will be sold at our stadium including inside the gates or in the parking lots or street.
9. **PATRONS WHO LEAVE THE STADIUM** will not be allowed to re-enter without paying. This includes patrons with passes.
10. **ANIMALS** are not allowed in the stadium. Service dogs allowed with documentation.
11. **BICYCLES, SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, FRISBEES, DRONES, ROLLERBLADES, and BALLS OF ALL TYPES** are not allowed in the stadium.
12. **AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY** will be admitted onto the field before, during, or after the game.
13. **AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY** will be allowed to cross over to the opposing side.
14. **PATRONS WITHOUT TICKETS** must enter through the pass gate and show proper credentials.
15. **PRESS BOX PASSES** must be picked up at the elevator on the Home side.

While fun, enjoyment and school spirit are important, safety is our #1 concern here at Celina I.S.D. These rules were established with that in mind.

STADIUM REGULATIONS

1. DRESSING ROOMS

- a. Dressing rooms will open 2 ½ hours prior to game time.
- b. Celina I.S.D. will NOT provide towels.
- c. Celina I.S.D. is not responsible for any articles left in the dressing room before, during or after the game.

2. TICKET GATES

- a. Gates will open 1½ hours prior to game time.
- b. There are no in-and-out privileges; re-entry requires the purchase of a new ticket. This is a Celina I.S.D. rule.
- c. Celina I.S.D. Bobcat Field is a tobacco free facility and tobacco use is prohibited.

3. PRESS BOX

- a. Admittance to the press box is by *Press Box Pass* only. There is one exception: Coaches with *Sideline Passes* wearing proper coaching attire do not need *Press Box Passes* to enter the press box.
- b. *Press Box Passes* that have not previously been acquired from the Administrative Assistant (Cindy Sharrock) must be picked up at the elevator entrance.
- c. The press box will open 1½ hours prior to game time.

4. PLAYING FIELD

- a. Team warm-up areas are as follows:
 - i. HOME TEAM North end from 50-yard line to the end zone closest to the field house.
 - ii. VISITING TEAM South end from 50-yard line to end zone closest to the scoreboard.
- b. All team personnel that are not in game uniform must have a *Sideline Pass*. This includes coaches, trainers, student trainers, student managers, and any other support staff. Cheerleaders that are in game uniforms do not need a pass, but any support staff not in uniform must have a *Sideline Pass*.
- c. ** Tobacco, sunflower seeds, gum, confetti, or shells of any kind is strictly prohibited. Signs are posted on the field and in the stadium. ** Failure to abide by this regulation will result in the cost of turf cleaning/repair at the offending school's expense.
- d. Absolutely NO glass bottles, cans, or food on the field. This includes cheerleaders and their support groups.
- e. All equipment such as training tables, fans, and heaters must have a protective base. Please make prior arrangements with the stadium manager.
- f. No live mascots are allowed.
- g. No cannons or confetti will be allowed. All large mechanical noisemakers, i.e., large air horns, must be on your own side and face your spectators. Noisemakers of any kind are not allowed on the field or inside the fence surrounding the field.
- h. Band props must not mark or scar the field. This includes painted items as well as sharp wheels or other equipment that may damage the artificial surface.

- i. Only personnel with *Sideline Passes* can be on the field. Spectators are not allowed on the field before, during, or after the games.
- j. No ice chests will be allowed in the stadium. Exceptions include the competing teams, bands, and drill teams.
- k. NO **paper** banners or signs are allowed in the stadium, unless previously approved by the stadium manager.
- l. All “run-through” signs must be vinyl or cloth. Additionally, the paint must be permanent that does not run when wet. DO NOT use painted paper.

5. STADIUM BLEACHERS


- a. Absolutely no climbing or jumping over rails from the bleachers to the field.
- b. Absolutely no crossover by spectators from home side of stadium to visitor side of stadium or vice-versa.
- c. Spirit signs used in the bleachers must be made of vinyl or cloth with permanent paint that does not run when wet. Signs must be ***tied*** to the stadium railing. Taping of signs to any stadium structure will not be permitted. No paper banners or signs or crepe paper allowed, unless previously approved by the stadium manager.



Bobcat Field Tailgating Safety Guidelines

Tailgating at Bobcat Field is a one of a kind experience in Celina. In order to foster an atmosphere of safety and enjoyment for all Bobcat Field attendees, Celina I.S.D. established the following safety guidelines for tailgating at the stadium.

- ❖ It is recommended that islands located in the parking lots be used for cooking areas when tailgating.
- ❖ Please do not allow children or other guests to throw Frisbees, footballs, etc. in and around parking areas or roadways.
- ❖ Please do not block an adjacent parking spot or lane with grills, chairs, or other paraphernalia while tailgating.
- ❖ If you use a large vehicle such as an RV for tailgating in a reserved parking area, the owner of the RV must purchase a minimum of two reserved parking spots.
- ❖ No alcohol or tobacco products are to be used on school district property.
- ❖ Please ensure that your tailgating area is clean when finished and all trash is placed in appropriate trash receptacles.
- ❖ Parking lots are not available for tailgating until after 4:30 PM on game days.
